Unauthorized Access to Card Data at Target Stores

You may have heard news of a security breach affecting an unspecified number of credit/debit cards at U.S. Target stores. Target has made a public announcement confirming the breach and engaged a data security firm to investigate. This breach may have affected credit or debit card purchases made between November 27, 2013 and December 15, 2013.

At this point, we do not have any other information about this breach, including the card numbers affected or which Target locations were involved.

Albina Community Bank does monitor your debit and credit card transactions for potentially fraudulent activity. If we suspect fraudulent debit card use, we'll be calling you to validate the legitimacy of your transactions. Your response to our call is critical to prevent potential risk and to avoid restrictions we may place on the use of your card. Please make sure that we have the correct phone number on file so that we may contact you immediately.

We also ask that you be diligent in monitoring transaction activity on your account. We offer free online banking and telephone banking, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Login frequently and ensure that all transactions are valid. Also, make sure you review your monthly account statements for accuracy – statements are available in paper or electronic format.

If you need assistance with our online banking and telephone banking systems, please visit an Albina Community Bank office or give us a call. And, if you see anything out of the ordinary when reviewing your account activity, let us know right away.
